#### Agenda Item No. 18.01 Opening Remarks by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor

The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor welcomed all esteemed members of the Board of Management in its 18<sup>th</sup> meeting held on August 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022. She informed that the University is conducting the classes' in an offline mode as per the Academic Calendar of the University. The End Semester Exams of all the students except B.Tech (first year) were conducted smoothly. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor also informed that the admission process for Post Graduate programs M.Tech, M.Plan, MCA, MBA and Ph.D. programs are in-progress for the Academic Year 2022-23. The admission process for the B.Tech and B.Arch Programs will commence after the declaration of JEE result. Admission to BBA Program will be conducted jointly for DTU, NSUT and IGDTUW through CMAC. She also apprised that 4 Professors and 5 Associate Professors have joined the University and the Recruitment process for Assistant Professor and Non-Teaching has been conducted.

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor also apprised the following achievements of the University after conduct of 17<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Board of Management on March 14, 2022: -

- MoU between IGDTUW and UniMAP Malaysia: MOU between IGDTUW and UniMAP Malaysia has been signed on 07.04.2022 in presence of Hon'ble Dy. CM and Education Minister of Malaysia.
- The Awards Asia 2022 for Outstanding Support for Students: IGDTUW has made India Proud by being shortlisted in the "The Awards Asia 2022" under the category "Outstanding Support for Students".
- New Code of Education 2022 Award: Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of IGDTUW was conferred with 'New Code of Education 2022 Award', which was given by distinguished Prof. Anil D. Sahasrabudhe, Chairperson AICTE on 25<sup>th</sup> March 2022.
- Nara Institute of Science and Technology (NAIST), JAPAN has selected two students of IGDTUW for its prestigious internship NAIST-ASC from October-2022 till May 2023.
- IGDTUW has incepted Centre for Sustainable Development to extend knowledge about CDS and take up all the activities related to CDS for the benefit of Society.
- University has bagged the following positions in INDIA TODAY Rankings 2022:
  - ✓ 4<sup>th</sup> in Government Colleges with Best Values for Money.
  - ✓ 7<sup>th</sup> in Government Colleges with Best Placement Record.
  - ✓ 10<sup>th</sup> in Government Colleges with Lowest Fees.
- To provide the opportunities to the students to carryout internship, the University has conducted 10 Internship programs during June-July 2022 in different emerging areas.
- The student placements in the Academic Year 2021-22 has reaped remarkable offers from top companies Amazon, Microsoft, Google, Expedia, Goldman Sachs, Uber and many more. Amazon Dublin has offered highest package of Rs. 1.2 crore to 3 students of the University. Students also bagged International Internship offers during summer 2021 from Facebook, London and Protex AI Ltd., Ireland. The University has achieved a significant increment in full time offers by 39.04% and internship offers by 55.08%. The average CTC received by the students is approximately 18 LPA and average stipend for summer internship of INR 64,000 per month for the Academic Year 2021-22.
