Agenda Item No. 12.01 Opening Remarks by the Vice-Chancellor

At the outset, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, IGDTUW welcomed the Hon'ble Chairman of Board of Management and esteemed members of the Board of Management of IGDTUW. The Vice Chancellor informed that in-spite of pandemic situation and lockdown, last quarter was filled with challenges, great initiatives, noticeable achievements, rewards and recognitions. She apprised the following achievements of the University:

- Awarded 2nd Rank by ARIIA: Indira Gandhi Delhi Technical University for Women has secured 2ndrank out of more than 650 universities in the category of Higher Educational Institutions Exclusively for Women in the award ceremony of Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA) Rankings 2020. Organized on 18 August 2020 by the Ministry of Education, the ceremony was graced by the Hon'ble Vice President of India
- University has received **DIAMOND** rating from QS I-GAUGE.
- University has been conferred Shrimati Sushma Swaraj "STREE SHAKTI SAMMAN" due to its vision and commitment.
- University has received UGC 12B status.
- All the B. Tech and M. Tech Programs of the University are now approved by the AICTE.
- One of the M. Tech (IT) students, Ms. Monika Kumari received a prestigious FS-ISAC, USA scholarship of USD 10,000 to pursue research and development work in Information and Cyber Security. She is among the top 14 girls' students selected for this scholarship across the world.
- The Department of Mechanical and Automation organized a National Conference on Innovations in Mechanical Engineering and Automation on 18th September, 2020 in an online mode.
- Admissions for the Academic session 2020-21 were accomplished in the month of August for all the Post Graduate and Ph.D programs in an online mode. A three weeks Students Induction Program was organized for all the new admitted students from 13th August to 28th August, 2020.
- Admissions process for the various Under Graduate Programs viz. BTech, B Arch, BBA
 is currently going on. EWS reservations as per Government guidelines have been
 implemented in all the Programs.
- One Week Faculty Development Program cum Workshop on Artificial Intelligence and Speech Technology (AIST) was organized from 17th-21st August, 2020 in collaboration with IBM and Anveshan Foundation as a prelude to the 2nd International Conference on Artificial Intelligence and Speech Technology which was held on 19-20th November, 2020.
- Two AICTE Sponsored ATAL FDP programs namely, "Deep Learning and AI" was organized from 21-25th September, 2020 and on "Response Effectiveness, Organizing Self, Attitudinal Shift, Decision Making (ROAD)" was organized from 7-11th September, 2020 which fetched an overwhelming response.
