- 1. Facilitate the care of children with special needs, acknowledging the high cost of care giving.
- 2. Facilitate education, training and employability of persons with disability, so that they may fulfill their role and potential in society and lead a life of dignity.
- 3. Help ensure survival of the person with special needs and their family.

Under the scheme, financial assistance of Rs. 2500/- per month is credited to the bank accounts of such persons residing in Delhi. The scheme is available to all persons fulfilling the following eligibility criteria-

New Age between 0-59 years

- Disability at least 40% and above and have a disability certificate issued from a govt.
- c) Resident of Delhi for at least 5 years prior to application
- d) Family income not more than Rs 1.00 lakh per annum
- e) Having an Aadhaar number
- f) Having a single-operation bank a/c. This provision may be relaxed for minors or those not able to operate a single a/c. The a/c also needs to be linked with the Aadhaar number of the applicant.
