

IGDTUW Organizes “VIKSIT BHARAT@2047 EVENT IDEATHON”

The Ideathon was organized by Department of Artificial Intelligence and Data Sciences, in collaboration with E-Cell’ IGDTUW, with the which took place on January 24, 2024, at IGDTUW, starting at 11 am. The event saw an impressive turnout with 120+ entries, representing 120 different ideas for the future of India, attracting participants from both inside and outside colleges.

Participation and Theme: The ideathon's theme, "Viksit Bharat @2047," aimed to inspire participants to envision a developed India in the year 2047. The event featured four exciting tracks:

- 1. MedTech Marvels (Healthcare)**
- 2. FinTech Fusion (Finance)**
- 3. WanderWisdom 2047 (Tourism)**

Idea Submission and Selection: The initial round took place online, where participants submitted their ideas. The team carefully reviewed all submissions and selected the top 5 ideas from each track. presented their ideas. Then the top 20 ideas progressed to the offline round.

Offline Presentation and Awards: The top 20 teams had the opportunity to present their ideas in front of the panel of judges in offline mode. After thorough evaluations, the judges identified the top 3 ideas across all tracks. To recognize their outstanding contributions, each winning team received a cash prize from a pool of Rs. 10,000.
