

Pre-Matric, Post-Matric and Merit-Cum-Means based Scholarship Schemes for 2019-20.

Last date for submission of Online applications for Post-Matric and Merit-Cum-Means Scholarship (Fresh and Renewal)	Upto 31st October, 2019

Eligibility

- The applicant should belong to any one form the notified Minority communities viz. Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists, Zoroastrians (Parsis) and Jains.
- The applicant should be pursuing studies in India in Government or Private Universities/Institutes/Colleges/Schools.
- The course being pursued should be of Minimum one year duration.
- The applicant should have secured 50% marks in the last annual Board/Class examination.

- Applicant is advised to give only that bank account details which remains in active mode or compliant as per bank's instructions so that payment of scholarship does not fail.
